MIAMI—On Saturday, May 30th from 9:00am-3:00pm Miami Lighthouse and Walgreens, with support from The Miami Foundation's GLBT Community Projects Fund, invite the entire community to attend "Happy and Healthy Living" a free fun filled LGBT Fair celebrating diversity. This event invites the community to get vision screenings and low vision evaluations, HIV/STD testing, private pharmacy consultations, legal Q&A and information from community health and social service organizations. The Fair will also celebrate diversity with musical performances by the Miami Gay Men's Chorus and the Miami Lighthouse Musicians. Complimentary workshops, activities giveaways and demos that include health oriented sessions, such as, barre yoga and sexy fitness will be offered.

State Representative David Richardson, the first openly gay member of the Florida Legislature, will welcome participants at 9:30am, and at 12:00pm Dr. Steven Santiago, Medical Director of Care Resource, will be giving a keynote address on 'The Health of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender People in South Florida.' "The Fair could not be held at a better time, as research suggests that some subgroups of the LGBT community have more chronic conditions as well as higher prevalence and earlier onset of disabilities which in some cases leads to vision loss. The fair will not only address these health concerns but it will address them in a fun and exciting way emphasizing happy and healthy living" said Virginia Jacko, President & CEO of Miami Lighthouse. Complimentary breakfast, lunch and snacks will be provided.

Miami Lighthouse seeks to address the health concerns of the local community, including eye health, through this one day Fair organized around health and social service issues related to the LGBT community.
