Great News! Our young artists are big winners

We are truly excited and proud to tell you that young artists from our second grade class and our summer camp, despite their vision disabilities, have won both first and second place in the American Printing House "Insights Art" International Art Contest! There were 280 entries from around the world, according to Aaron Hill, Art Instructor for our Miami Lighthouse Social Group Activities Program.



First Place Winner: "SAVE THE EARTH & SEE TURTLES" was created by children from our summer camp. The "turtles" were created out of recycled paper cups, colored with markers and adorned with gems and stones. The huge 48"x48" piece was painted by several summer campers. Clear plastic bowls were colored with markers and attached to the "world" which was circled with a hula hoop. This creative piece also made it into the top ten of Channel 10's eARTh Day Contest.



Second Place Winner: "MAGICAL MONET" was created by four of Miami Lighthouse 2nd grade art students. The children first painted the abstract water background on four separate canvases, then created the water lily pads with pastel markers. The flowers were created from egg cartons and cupcake paper holders. The canvases were then joined together to create "Magical Monet" inspired by Claude Monet's "Water Lilies".
