"Reinforcing pre-fire preparations, for instance, planning and practicing an escape plan in the event of an actual emergency, installing smoke alarms, and involving the Fire Department to help plan an escape route are very important safety lessons and even more so for our visually impaired students at Miami Lighthouse," said Virginia Jacko, President & CEO of Miami Lighthouse.
